



Givaudan acquires a further Nestlé facility in Kempththal

Geneva, 9 July 2002 – Following Nestlé's decision to concentrate its culinary research in Singen (South Germany) and to discontinue its research activities in Kempththal (Zurich, Switzerland), Givaudan will acquire these facilities in Kempththal.

On January 18, 2002, Givaudan has – in the context of the FIS acquisition - announced to acquire the Nestlé production facilities in Kempththal.

With this new purchase, Givaudan will own the entire former Nestlé site in Kempththal. This is part of Givaudan's long term strategy to consolidate its flavour activities and assure future growth in this domain.

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
